Three 100" screens (2 m x 1.5 m per screen) have been arranged overlapping each other:



The HoloPro™ screens were specified by renowned Chicago interior designer and UC alumna Eva Maddox, principal at Perkins & Will Architects. They are a special part of a four-story floating staircase atrium in the George and Helen Smith Athletics Museum located in the new Richard Lindner Center. The screens are mentioned as "Elements in particular that won't go unnoticed including a soaring glass trophy case suspended in mid-air and a 20-foot-tall video screen." They are used to show history videos of the University's sports programs. The project was done in association with Xibitz (Grand Rapids, Michigan) and AV Resources (Chicago).
